Royco's vendor's Suppression Services include:

Mail Preference Service: Identifies people on the Direct Marketing Association "Do Not Mail" list.

Deceased Master File Suppression: Flags addresses whose primary residents have died (per U.S. Social Security Administration and other sources).

Prison Suppression: Uses a national directory of addresses identified as prisons.

Business/Shopping Center Addresses: Compiled from regional White Pages listings.

College Addresses: Uses a database of ZIP Codes assigned to colleges or universities.

Pander Files: Uses requests from outside groups to have name/addresses removed from lists.

Military ZIP Codes: Flags addresses featuring ZIP Codes corresponding to military installations.

Nursing Homes: Matches addresses against those that have been identified as nursing homes.

Relative Input of Another's Death: Uses a database of notifications from relatives of deceased persons.

Retirement Homes: Isolates addresses that have been identified as retirement homes.

Trailer Parks: Flags mobile home/trailer parks.
